## Abstinence Education Update . . . Step Out on Faith with Us! Count Your Blessings . . . Name them one by one . . .

Each of these years represents the school years that the SOPC received TANF Funding for Abstinence Education. Because of the economic situation in Highland County, our funding hasn't been renewed . . . not because they don't want to . . . we're a part of the many cut-backs in our county.

Over the past four years our Abstinence Educator, Connie Huber, has presented the life-changing abstinence message to over 5,500 young people in the five Highland County High Schools and Middle Schools. During the 2010-2011 school year, the messages was presented to 1,610 students. It costs approximately \$14 per student to fund this program.

On June 16 the SOPC Board of Directors voted to step out on faith and to fund the Abstinence Education Program. The program costs \$22,410 to operate each year. That pays for Connie's salary, her mileage, supplies and curriculum updates.

### This is what we are doing:

- The dollars once earmarked for our monthly mortgage payment will now go to the Abstinence Education Fund: \$3,000.
- All Baby Bottle Blessings Project dollars will go to the Abstinence Fund.
- Any money over and above the \$10,000 goal for the Walk/Ride/Run for Life on Saturday, October 1, 2011 will go to the Abstinence Fund.
- We are searching for renewable grants to help sustain this program.

### Here is what you can do:

- Step out on faith with us and make a commitment to help the SOPC fund the Abstinence Program.
  - Over 1,600 students will hear the message in 2011—2012. Will you prayerfully consider a gift over and above your regular gift to reach one student (\$14), two students (\$28), ten (\$140), or 50 (\$700).
  - One church is already on board. They have committed to give a monthly gift to the Abstinence Education Fund over and above their regular monthly gift.
- Pray for the SOPC Staff and Board as we seek funding for this life-changing program.
- Pray for Connie as she prepares for the 2011—2012 school year.
- Thank God for the partnership that the Center has had over the past four years with Highland County Jobs and Family Services.

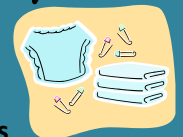
